Colour: Very deep purple in colour.
Nose: Delightful perfume of spicy oak and fruit.
Palate: Floods the palate with vanilla, spice and fresh plums with lashings of black cherry.
Style: A Shiraz of great complexity, this wine has long gentle tannins which provides excellent length to a balanced, full flavoured wine with a refined spicy finish.
