The West Australian - Ray Jordan Wine Guide 2018 - *"The style is similar to the previous vintage, although there is slightly more body and depth. Complex mix of spices with coffee grinds and chocolaty plummy fruit characters. Smooth and seamlessly structured with neat oak and tannin balance. This is a very promising shiraz from this region and I look forward to seeing what else is in store in the coming years."*

TASTING NOTES:

Colour: Deep purple.
Nose: Dark berry fruit and floral aromas with subtle spice and toasty oak characteristics.
Palate: Floods the palate with lashings of black cherry.
Style: A Shiraz of great complexity. Fermented naturally then macerated on skins for 21 days to extract all the natural colour and tannins possible.
