“From a 0.5ha block, hand-picked, sorted and post fermentation remained on skins for 14 days. This has given body, depth and detail. Red and black fruit, brown spices and fine savoury tannins, 30% new oak all soaked up.”

TASTING NOTES:

A medium bodied wine with a bright crimson colour which shows aromas of fresh plum and ground coffee with a chocolate twist. The palate shows flavours of raspberry and blackberry fruits with a hint of Grandma's custard. The wine finishes with balanced tannin and is well suited to age for up to 10 years.
